

Magic Soccer Club FAQs

Who is Magic Soccer Club?--The Magic Soccer Club is a volunteer-run, non-profit youth soccer program, primarily servicing families in the Memorial High School attendance area. The mission of Magic is to provide a fun and fulfilling soccer experience to any child with a desire to play soccer. We have teams for all ages, from kindergarten through high school, ranging from recreational to competitive teams.

Are scholarships available?--The Magic Soccer Club strives to make as many resources available to our members as possible in order to service each child at their level of interest. To help meet this end, assistance is available to any child in financial need for any of Magic's programs.

Is Magic and MAYSA the same thing?--No, however we are connected. MAYSA is the governing body for local soccer clubs. There are 36 clubs within MAYSA, including Magic. MAYSA is part of the [Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association](#) (WYSA) which is a part of the United States Youth Soccer Association (USYSA)

Is Magic and the Alliance the same thing?--Magic is a member of the Alliance. The Alliance is a cooperative effort between [Magic](#), [Regent](#), [Verona](#), [Shorewood](#), soccer Clubs and our Premier partner, the [Madison 56ers](#) to provide the best possible soccer environment for ALL players. The [Alliance](#) facilitates the ability of each player to participate on a team that is most appropriate to their level of development and interest. Together we support teams ranging from local recreational league soccer to the regional premier level. For various reasons players from Magic, Regent and Verona may combine to form a team called an Alliance Team. Our goal is to keep kids playing soccer, working together to make sure no one is left out.

When does the soccer season start?--Our season follows that of the Madison Area Youth Soccer Association calendar. We have 8 games in the fall and 8 games in the spring. Teams are generally formed in the fall and continue through together through the spring. However we do occasionally form spring only teams at the recreational level.
