Volunteer Opportunities

Magic Soccer Club is a non-profit club. We have a volunteer Board of Directors and are dependent upon parent volunteers to help us keep things running smoothly. We need your help! In addition to the coaching & managing of teams, the Club needs a continuous supply of parent volunteers to serve on the Board, as age-commissioners, provide field maintenance, tournament workers etc... We ask that each team provide a minimum of 10 volunteer hours per year or, one hour per family. Below is a brief description of a few of the opportunities available.

Volunteer Team Contact Person

- This person will be the major contact for Magic. If we need volunteers for specific events, this person will be contacted and help the Club fill any necessary positions. Yearlong commitment.

Ball Kid Supervision

- Magic provides Ball kids to help at the Memorial boys and girls soccer games. Kids need to be U10 and above, rec or classic. We need one parent volunteer to be on site with the group to help during the entire game. One game commitment for each season (boys and girls Varsity).

Tournament Volunteers

- During tournaments, we will need Field Marshals and people to help with check in. Shifts usually last 2-3 hours.

Tryouts

- We need people primarily to help check in players, give them their numbers and direct kids to appropriate fields. Shifts last 2-3 hours.

Tryout Commissioners

- These individuals work prior and during the Tryout process to help form teams for one age/gender group. They help complete the roster and present it to MAYSA. This job is completed when Tryouts are done.

Age Commissioners

- These people are assigned to one age group and work with that age group throughout the year. Age Commissioners often have a child within that group. They help make sure all kids are on teams at the beginning of the season and problem -solve with teams, parents, coaches or managers as problems or issues arise.

Board Members

- Magic is always seeking new Board members, as we need fresh ideas from new people so that we may continue to provide the best service to our membership. Magic is responsible for putting in place any directives from WYSA while developing opportunities best suited for our Club. Board meets one time per month with members working on various jobs throughout the year as needed.

Field Maintenance

- People are needed for lining fields, rotating and repairing goal areas, monitoring fields for holes and rocks and storing nets. Would require several hours, 2-3 times per season.

Website

- Magic needs a skilled person to help us upgrade and maintain our site during the year. We will be using our website more frequently in the future as a means to efficiently distribute information to our membership. This would be an ongoing commitment.
